### Nomination Process, forms and deadline

- Self-nominating Candidates are required to complete both the ***District Leader nomination form*** and the ***Officer Agreement and Release Statement form***.
- Nominators are required to complete the ***District Leader nomination form*** only.
- Officers being nominated by another must complete the ***Officer Agreement and Release Statement form*** only.
- Both forms can be filled in on-line and saved.

- Whether you are self-nominating or nominating another, please ensure your completed paperwork is sent to and received by the Chair of the District Leadership Committee, Laurel Francis, DTM, PDDG by midnight 15 December 2018 (see details at bottom of page 2)

Nominations received are assessed by the District Leadership Committee (formerly the District Nominating Committee). Elections for these leadership roles will be held at the District 112 Council Annual Business meeting in Hamilton on Saturday 4 May 2019. There will also be a Candidate Showcase on the Friday evening.

The District Leadership Committee (DLC) will assess the candidates and report the list of successful candidates to the District Director no later than **23 March 2019**. The District Director, Toni Sharp DTM will report the list of successful candidates to members of the District Council no later than 6 **April 2019**.
