## Division Challenges

Issues	Solutions
Overwhelm continues to be an issue. Many club officers are dealing with this in several areas of their lives, are under a lot of pressure at work and home, etc, and are sensitive to too much volume and intensity.	Trying to be as clear, helpful, and efficient as possible in communications, and regularly signposting events coming up – i.e., trying to be as helpful as possible in communications, bearing in mind an overwhelmed audience.
Membership declines in several clubs. 50% of clubs now have less than 20 members. (41% in the last report.) 29% of clubs now have 12 or fewer members. (13% in the last report.)	Being as encouraging and as helpful as possible.
