Division Celebrations & Successes

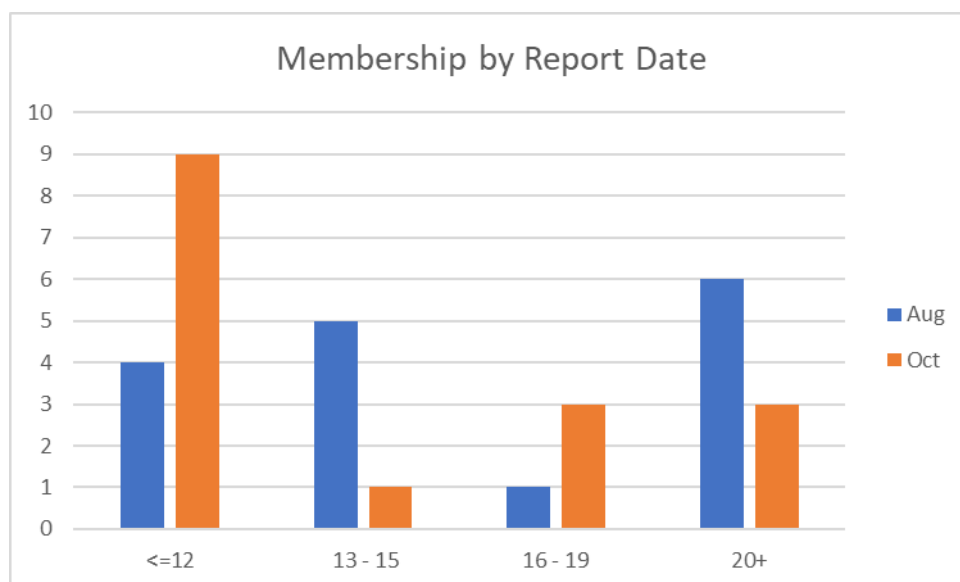
