Area, Division and District Contests

The most recent update from Toastmasters International regarding contests was received on the 24th of August 2020, signed by the International President and CEO and states:

"effective immediately, all Speech Contests at the Area-, Division-, and District-levels *must* be conducted online. This applies to all Districts regardless of their local authorities' restrictions or lack thereof, related to COVID-19. This decision was not made lightly. This decision will ensure a consistent experience for the speech contestants and officials throughout the various levels in all Districts. With contests starting as early as the end of 2020, there is too much uncertainty about the current situation and the Board felt strongly that the burden of this decision should rest with them and not be put upon our District leaders."

Some members will be delighted for the opportunity to compete online and others will be disappointed not to compete in person. This decision is the result of being a part of an international organisation that must juggle the needs of 144 countries. Let us view this as an opportunity to further enhance our skills before we return to holding Area, Division and District contests in person again.

Our Program Quality Director, Stephen Budai, is holding online training sessions for contest functionaries. Please do attend these sessions, as we have many tips to ensure our Division contests are run smoothly. It is easy to pick up which contest officials have taken the time to attend training, thereby enhancing their online performance which creates a better experience for both the contestants and the audience.

This gives us an opportunity to learn more about our members and for you to ask us any questions you may have.
