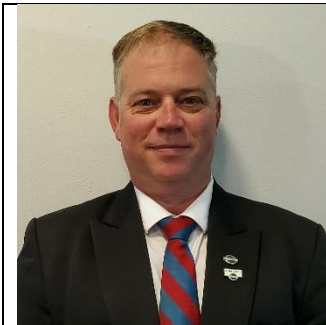


James Hippolite DTM


Division O Director
