Geographic separation makes it hard to meet together in person as a team.	Utilize the zoom media to unite the team. this could make training more interactive if given the right amount of diversity in presentation.
There seems to be a lack of work together from some of the clubs either from low member fatigue or large migration out due to work pressure	Online training for club officers to recognize early signs of deterioration or decline and then they can be offered help before there is significant loss or membership.
