Speaking of Levin Club has only 9 members and needs a coach (none assigned).

R3

Pania Club has 5 DCP goals but still needs 3 more paid members.
Hastings Toastmasters Club has 4 DCP goals but still needs 8 more paid members.
Hastings Toastmasters Club has only 12 members and needs a coach (none assigned).
Havelock North Club has only 11 members and needs a coach (none assigned).
CHB Toastmasters Club has only 12 members and needs a coach (none assigned).
Bay City Toastmasters Club has only 8 members and needs a coach (none assigned).
