Club Coaches - what clubs have a coach appointed, and what clubs still need a coach appointed?

- L1 Eco City Waitakere Club (9364) This club is eligible for a club coach, with 6 members.
- L1 Henderson-Waitakere Toastmasters (7761) This club is eligible for a club coach, with 8 members.
- L2 Shore Toastmasters On Saturday (2677176) This club is eligible for a club coach, with 8 members
- L3 Milford Club (4298) This club is eligible for a club coach, with 8 members.
- L3 TWG Toastmasters (7860039) It's exciting to see that this club is back in the fold. This club has a club coach in place and registered members that aren't reflected in the report because of a technical issue regarding a payment to TI that was allocated to the previous period instead of this current period. This is being investigated. Hopefully, this doesn't cause us to lose this organisation when we have only just gotten it back.
- L4 Belmont Club (8787) This club is eligible for a club coach, with 6 members. The club is working on a plan with a coach, may move venue.
- L4 Review Toastmasters (4760508) This club is eligible for a club coach with 8 members. All experienced members, all heavily involved in helping other clubs to thrive.
- L4 Takapuna Midday Toastmasters Club (622009) This club is eligible for a club coach, with 6 members. Planning Speechcraft now that the TI shop is open. Membership should soon be 10.
- L4 Takapuna Toasters Club (1644891) This club is eligible for a club coach with 4 members. No current updates.
