Club Coaches - what clubs have a coach appointed, and what clubs still need a coach appointed?

Staci Marris while yet to be appointed formally is acting as a club coach for Onehunga. We have 6 clubs eligible for a club coach, 3 of those are corporate clubs and the Area Director is working closely with those clubs. One club, 2 degrees remains without members and will probably close although healthy conversations are continuing with the club. Again, a corporate club. The other clubs without club coaches that are eligible are having discussions with their Area Directors on the specific needs.

Club Support – what clubs would benefit from additional support, and what support is required?

The corporate clubs in particular are getting strong support from their Area Director, and he seems to be building a strong connection with them. Area M2 has suffered from a resignation of their Area Director, soon to be replaced. In the next month 2 Area Directors are overseas, not returning until just before the Area Contests so the remaining Area Directors have agreed to assist during that period of absence. Pathways support is still variable, hopefully the upgrade announced will help to alleviate this issue. COT was mixed, the attendance recording problem was frustrating.

What events have been held, and what feedback have you received?

Division M has had two Division Council meetings and has others planned for September and October related to the Area and then Division contests. The contests appear to be on track for the 23rd September and 7th October and Area Directors are working across each other's Areas to assist as competition chairs. Planning has begun for the Division M&N conference now moved to the 28th October. The 4 educational sessions being discussed include how to evaluate well, how to use the voice, how to use body language and the lessons learnt from the international speech semifinal.
