Support

Club Coaches - what clubs have a coach appointed, and what clubs still need a coach appointed?

No Clubs currently have active and regular Club Coach involvement. Refer comment below.

Club Support – what clubs would benefit from additional support, and what support is required?

• From a club member number perspective there are currently 7 clubs in the Division who are eligible for a club coach. (Early Birds, ANZ Bank, Moo Talk, Watch this Space, Ingenio, Waiheke Island and Varsity. We need to encourage these clubs to have at least



one club officer complete the Club Coach Program Training module so that the clubs are fully eligible, and then look to appoint a club coach.

- Ingenio (refer above) is struggling with numbers; assistance is being provided (including from Area Director, Division Director and District Director) to encourage the Club to continue. One avenue is working with Biz Talk and Varsity (the other 2 Auckland University Clubs)
- Biz Talk had been suspended; however has now had a big growth in membership and is working in conjunction with Varsity.
- A number of the Clubs are still not fully pursuing Pathways, including at the Officer level. There is a focus to encourage this. Further educationals, presentations, assistance with the website may be warranted.

New Clubs – Prospects, leads, clubs in formation

What is the progress, and what support is needed?

There is current discussion of a new club being formed at Watercare, where the N3 Area Director has been running a Speechcraft course.

Clubs suspended/requesting suspension.

Currently there are no clubs in suspension; Ingenio is the most at risk. There is also talk of Watch This Space dissolving the club.

Division Events

A number of Clubs seem to pay little regard to the Toastmasters International requirements; and do not follow/engage with recording Pathways speeches; nor attend Club Officer Training. The increase in fee is being talked about and there is a significant risk of losing membership as a result of this.
