October Dashboard

The first quarter showed steady membership growth in the District. Since 1 July this year, 365 new members have joined our District. Since 1 October membership payments grew by 231. Our club base at 1 September was 138. By 30 September it dropped to 123. This fluctuation is to be expected at the end of each semi-annual period. Those clubs that didn't achieve good standing status at 1 October need our support and we wish them well in their efforts to return to a club of good standing very soon.
