Support

Club Coaches - what clubs have a coach appointed, and what clubs still need a coach appointed?

No Clubs currently have active and regular Club Coach involvement. Refer comment below.

Club Support – what clubs would benefit from additional support, and what support is required?

• From a club member number perspective there are currently 5 clubs in the Division who are eligible for a club coach. (Early Birds, ANZ Bank, Moo Talk, Ma Runga Waka and Toastmasters on Fanshawe). We need to encourage these clubs to have at least one

- club officer complete the Club Coach Program Training module so that the clubs are fully eligible, and then look to appoint a club coach.
- Ingenio has been suspended as noted above. Assistance has been offered (including from Area Director, Division Director and District Director) to encourage the Club to continue. However, engagement has not been forthcoming.
- Biz Talk is working in conjunction with Varsity. We need to ensure that the appropriate path is followed for this to continue.
- Other than the clubs mentioned above and below, Orators of Demosthenes (KPMG
 Corporate club) is the only club that did not pay its dues on time. It still has 7 members
 and KPMG executive are supportive of the club continuing. The Division and Area
 Director are working to ensure the club has the support it needs.
- A number of the Clubs are still not fully pursuing Pathways, including at the Officer level.
 Also a number of clubs are doing Pathways speeches; simply not recording in both
 Base Camp and Club Central and are therefore not getting the recognition for it. There
 is a focus to encourage both of these. As well as one on one engagement, further
 educationals, presentations and assistance with the website is warranted.

New Clubs - Prospects, leads, clubs in formation.

What is the progress, and what support is needed?

There is current discussion of a new club being formed at Watercare, where the N3 Area Director has been running a Speechcraft course.

Clubs suspended/requesting suspension.

Ingenio has been suspended from 30.9.23.

Watch This Space has not made any fee payments this October and is looking to dissolve the club.
