### **Support**

Club Coaches - what clubs have a coach appointed, and what clubs still need a coach appointed?

9 clubs in the division are eligible for a club coach. No club coaches have been formally appointed. The Onehunga club and WNZL are the two clubs with the most pressing need.

Club Support – what clubs would benefit from additional support, and what support is required?

Pathways continues to be the biggest issue preventing clubs from achieving goals in the Toastmasters recognition program. 16 clubs in the division are showing little or no activity in pathways so the focus for the Area Directors will be to encourage the pathways completion steps in Toastmasters International. The steps to recognise speeches given within the pathways framework are not receiving support from the members a clear indicator the process needs change.

This round all Area Contests for the Evaluation and Prepared Speech contest were held on the same day and at the same location. Two combined Division M and N Council meetings were also held to run the combined Division M and N Evaluation and Prepared speech competition. The two Divisions have continued to work well together, Division M undertook the competition chair roles for these two competitions, and they ran smoothly and professionally although they did suffer some minor technical broadcasting issues. We ran an educational session on using Agile methodology in Toastmasters which was well received and will be repeated at the District conference.
