Support

Club Coaches - what clubs have a coach appointed, and what clubs still need a coach appointed?

No Clubs currently have active and regular Club Coach involvement. Refer comment below.

Club Support – what clubs would benefit from additional support, and what support is required?

As noted above the **red** clubs have had difficulties. The changes since the last report are:

- Varsity and Biztalk. Pre 31 March 2024 these 2 clubs were attempting to work together in the University space. As at 1 April there were only 2 fee renewals paid. This is disappointing and work is needed to see what can be done about reestablishing a strong Auckland University club.
- Kora Korero o Microsoft. This club was struggling with members and getting club officers to stand up. As at 1 April the club decided to put itself “on hold”. Conversations are continuing, with various opportunities to work with Microsoft to reestablish this club

As noted above the **turquoise** clubs need some encouragement in different areas.

- Early Birds. Although it’s member base has grown there are a lot of new members, it appears that Pathways is not being actively recorded in Club Central. Active assistance in this area when the new system comes out would be useful.



- Moo Talk. Again, although base members is retained active pursuance of Pathways appears lacking and Officer Training was not undertaken. Assistance has been tried; however the club seems unwilling. Needs some new initiative.
- ANZ Bank Auckland. Again, numbers seem Ok, but Pathways progress and attendance of Officer Training a concern. Active encouragement suggested.
- Waitemata. This club has been consistently antagonistic to Pathways; and to Officer Training. The Area Director has worked hard to try to get change. It is a slow process. Numbers seem to have dropped at 1 April 2024. Maybe this and the new Pathways system can be used as further encouragement for change.
