Concerning the four speech Contests for 2024 – 2025. I recommend to DEC that the speech contests are to be the Humorous, Table Topics and Evaluation contests. The International Speech contest is a requirement set by TI. Once the DEC approves this recommendation, I will ask our PQD to advise of this selection to all clubs, within one week of the meeting.

I can inform everyone that the Visitor Booklets have already been printed and will be available today. Although there is more in the plan, I look forward to sharing more details, as we all come together and take this plan on board. We are entering our new year – and we are ready to make a great success of the next 12 months.
