### **Area 1** - Gavin Lamb (Elect: Jeannet Penney)

On Top have stopped meeting, and one member has transferred to Bay of Islands. They haven't officially closed with the hope that they'll be able to relaunch it later in the year. The other clubs in Area 1 are strong, including Bay of Islands that is currently lower on members.

Whangarei Toastmasters Club has achieved Select Distinguished.

At this stage it doesn't look like any of the other clubs will reach distinguished status.

#### **Area 3** - Murray Coutts (Elect: Sonley Johnstone)

Owera Lunchtime has closed (suspended) and some members have transferred to other clubs. The other clubs in the area are doing well, with Murray's support.

Hibiscus Coast Club has achieved Distinguished status.

Silverdale-Orewa and Riverhead are very close to being distinguished, and Murray is assisting them where possible.

### Area 4 - Helen Madden (Elect: TBC)

This is generally a very strong area and most of the clubs have achieved their DCP goals. Sunnynook, while energetic, has now been suspended. However we are very close to satisfying the requirements needed to get them reinstated again, and are hoping to do this before the end of the TMI year.

East Coast Bays, Academic, and Albany have all achieved Presidents Distinguished! At this stage Kristin is unlikely to, and Sunnynook understandably isn't interested until they're reinstated.

I want to give a huge shout out to the three Area Directors in Division K - they have been outstanding.
