Regarding our District Officers, it is an absolute pleasure to announce that we were able to achieve 100% of our District Officer's trained for both the first and second round of training. Regarding the training of our club officers, I can report that almost 60% of all club officers were trained when I combine both the first and second round of training. The recommendation is to have at least 6 club officers at all our training sessions, which will include the extra voluntary training of Social Media, under the guidance of our PRM Kenneth Gustillo.
