I think PR activities such as posting group photos, winners, and member induction posters on social media, as well as guest invitation posters in community halls/supermarkets, will benefit. For this, I think support from D112 PRM to the Club VPPRs may help.

Division Events

What events have been held, and what feedback have you received?

For example – COT, Area or Division council meetings, Area or Division contests, workshops etc

- COT 2 has been organized online. The club officers were contacted over email and WhatsApp to achieve at least 4 out of 7 attendees. We also motivated clubs to achieve 7 out of 7 COT2 attendees. There was a good response. 8 out of 20 clubs within Div O attended 7 out of 7 COT2. Whereas 16 out of 20 clubs within Div O attended minimum 4 out of 7 COT2.
- Division council meetings for conducting area contests have been organized twice so far, both over Zoom. All of these meetings had 50% attendees. I felt low energy in the Area Directors since the new year.
- Contest chair and Chief Judge workshop has been promoted within the division O to understand the main duties before the contest season starts. Some of the Div O members attended it.
- Club contests for most of the areas will be over by mid-Feb, and then Area contests will be on 22nd Feb 2025. The Division O Conference is planned for 5th April 2025.
