With 955 new members joining District 112 this year, that is a significant increase of 8%. Just under a third of Clubs were distinguished. Sadly, we lost 8 (net) clubs from our base, including 2 of the 4 clubs to charter have gone into suspension and will close. Although some clubs were lost, many were saved with help and support from the Club Growth team but largely due to the determination of our clubs that pulled themselves up by their bootstraps and got back into good standing. There is still lots of work to do in the coming year – this can be eased by everyone doing their part by supporting each other in & between clubs, areas and divisions. I challenge you all to visit one new club each month – support and encourage each other and share ideas.
