Support

Club Coaches - what clubs have a coach appointed, and what clubs still need a coach appointed?

7 clubs have between 3-12 members so would qualify for requiring a club coach if one of their members has completed the club Coach Program. Onehunga lost their coach due to the coaches illness. Other clubs include: Wake UP, Daybreak, AM TM, CBD, EY and WNZL.

Challenges

What challenges is the Division facing, and what potential solutions/assistance is needed?

Issues	Solutions
Most of the clubs who are struggling with low membership numbers are clubs which do not actively promote the education programme.	Have ADs and PR managers support these clubs. Help them to enjoy engaging with the Pathways programme.
Clubs with low membership who will need an early visit and contact: Wake Up; Daybreak; AM TM; Onehunga; CBD; E&Y and WNZL.	It will be advisable for new Area Directors to approach the new committee presidents to ask them if they can make an informal visit sooner than the other stronger clubs. Ask the exec what support their clubs want. Tell them what the club Success Plan, attending COT and Area Council meetings can do for them if they are prepared to get involved.
