Support

Club Coaches - what clubs have a coach appointed, and what clubs still need a coach appointed?

No new appointments. The decision has been made within Achieve club to close. There are several challenges facing the club in terms of strategy for increasing membership (difficulties with technology / making club hybrid / retaining visitors when they opt to join Kickstart or Tauranga (which are significantly bigger clubs).

Club Support – what clubs would benefit from additional support, and what support is required? Kickstart could use additional support in convincing members to use pathways and achieve DCP goals. The membership base (35) is large, and the attitude towards Pathways is likely inhibiting new members from participating in it.
