#### Challenges

Issues	Solutions
Lack of full engagement in Area / Division / District activities, such as Club Officer Training and speech contests, by clubs.	Communication with club leadership, direct visits by Area Director and/or Division Director. Generally encourage club leaders to pass along information and permit members to make their own choices.
Low membership in clubs, especially in rural areas.	Collaborative efforts between PR team and respective Area Director, to create localized promotion campaigns.
